

Sisters of Mayhem v Fallout Femmes

HACKETTSTOWN, NJ - On Saturday, November 1st, the North Jersey Sisters Of Mayhem challenged Harrisburg Area Roller Derby's Fallout Femmes at Excel Roller Skating Center.

The Sisters opened up the show with Bitty Boom Boom pulling a 4-3 win over Harrisburg's Queen Of Pain. H.A.R.D.'s Roxie Riot answered back with a 4-3 win over Jenna Von Fury. In the fourth jam, the Fallouts really started digging in, with Skid Ho, Skate Edge and Queen Of Pain bringing in 36 points over the next three jams, to the Sisters' 3, giving the Fallouts a nice lead to work with. Jenna Von Fury came back strong in the seventh frame, scoring 9 points, but Fallout Skid Ho nearly matched her with 8, still adding substantial points on the board for the Fallouts. In the eighth jam, Roxie Riot slammed a 9-2 jam over Xero Tolerance, giving the Fallouts a nice 40 point lead. The Sisters were able to build up their defense, and keep the Fallouts scoring at a lower rate, but Harrisburg was still pulling wins, and edging the score up higher and higher. In the thirteenth jam, Jenna Von Fury once again came out in full force, and grabbed an 11 point jam to Skid Ho's 6. The final jam of the period was a 3-3 tie between Skate Edge and Belle N. Somebashin, and the period ended with the Fallouts up 96-50.

The Sisters Of Mayhem were able to pull some small wins early in the second period, but the fourth jam went the full two minutes, and resulted in a 12-12 tie between Queen Of Pain and Jenna Von Fury. As things intensified, the Fallouts were able to just edge out the Sisters over the next several jams. In the eighth frame, Queen Of Pain unleashed a 15-0 shutout over Belle N. Somebashin, being the highest scoring jam of the bout. Skate Edge followed up with a 9-4 jam over Bitty Boom Boom, creating a gap that would be insurmountable to the Sisters Of Mayhem. Jenna Von Fury let it all out on the eleventh jam, and scored 10-2 over Roxie Riot. The Sisters were fighting hard, but the Fallout's defense was tight. The fourteenth jam saw Skate Edge take an 11-4 chunk out of Belle N. Somebashin. In the final jam, Jenna Von Fury pulled yet another strong jam, shutting out Roxie Riot 8-0. The Fallouts kept their strong lead, and took home the win at 174-109.

Also skating for the Fallout Femmes were Plenty O'Toole, Bamm Bamm Brewskie, NastyNiss, Dosa Badazz, Cybil Disaobedience, Bela Lowblowski, Donna Rae Gunn, Brickhouse Intimidation and Lucretia McEvil. For the Sisters Of Mayhem were Sugar N. Spice, Razor De Rockefeller, Lil Miss Kamakaxe, Diamond Knuckles, Phoenix, Shock Value, Sucia Lokita and Hayley Contagious.

The highest scoring jam belonged to Queen Of Pain of the Fallout Femmes, who scored 15 points in one jam. For the Sisters Of Mayhem, it was Jenna Von Fury who scored 12 points in one jam. Harrisburg's Queen Of Pain scored the most points, scoring 65 points, which was 37% of her team's total. For the Sisters, it was Jenna Von Fury who scored 59 points, which was 54% of her team's total. The highest scoring jammer was New Jersey's Jenna Von Fury, who scored 59 points in 8 jams, giving her an average of 7.38 points per jam. For the Fallouts, it was Queen Of Pain, who scored 65 points in 9 jams, giving her an average of 7.22 points per jam. The Fallout Femmes averaged 5.80 points per jam, and the Sisters Of Mayhem averaged 3.63 points per jam. The highest jammer point differential went to Harrisburg's Queen Of Pain with +36 points. Jenna Von Fury had the Sister's highest jammer point differential with +23 points. Jersey's Jenna Von Fury and Harrisburg's Skate Edge were tied for the highest lead jammer status, both earning lead in 5 out of 8 jams, being 63% of their jams. The Fallout Femmes earned lead jammer in 15 of the bout's 30 jams, being 50% of the game. The Sisters Of Mayhem earned lead jammer in 12 of the bout's 30 jams, being 40% of their game. The referees called a total of 152 penalties. The Fallout Femmes had the most, earning 76 minors and 11 majors for a total of 87 penalties. The Sisters Of Mayhem earned 59 minors and 6 majors for a total of 65 penalties. The Penalty Princess was Harrisburg's Dosa Badazz, who picked up

12 minors and 3 majors for a total of 15 penalties. For the Sisters, it was a tie between Razor De Rockefeller and Xero Tolerance, who both earned 10 minors and one major for a total of 11 penalties.
